Report from the Compliance Committee

Purpose

To consider the report and recommendations of the Compliance Committee.

Discussion

The independent Chair of the Compliance Committee will present the report of the Compliance Committee's meeting, which is to be held from 5-7 October 2017.

The Compliance Committee will be considering a wide variety of matters, including:

- Reports from the Secretariat and Members on compliance related matters and an assessment of compliance of Members and Cooperating Non-Members (CNMs) with CCSBT management measures.
- Reports on any problems with the operation of CCSBT's measures.
- Review and revision of CCSBT MCS measures with the intention of ensuring that these measures are operating effectively and efficiently and are updated as appropriate. The measures to be considered include aspects of:
 - Catch Documentation Scheme (CDS);
 - Authorised vessels;
 - VMS;
 - Transshipment / Minimum Standards for Inspection in Port; and
 - IUU Vessel List.
- Consideration of CCSBT Policies and Arrangements, including:
 - The Compliance Action Plan for 2018-2020;
 - Minimum Performance Requirements;
 - Quality Assurance Reviews;
 - Template for Annual Report to the CC and EC;
 - Transshipment MoC with WCPFC; and
 - International Networks and Bilateral Arrangements.
- Action planned as part of the implementation of the CCSBT's Compliance Plan, including:
 - Monitoring of Markets and IUU Catch;
 - Cooperation with Non-Members;
 - Electronic Observation Technologies;
 - SBT Identification Technologies; and
 - Ongoing Identification and Sharing of Best Practices for MSC systems.

Recommendations may be made on these matters, which will require the attention of the Extended Commission.
